MALIBU SUNRISE encouraged to gain a clear, early lead, showed the way inside in hand on the backstretch and through the second bend, was put to urging deep stretch and widened command. ZONETTA rated from inside, picked up her pace into the second turn, steadily advanced along the rail, fought for second the last furlong and edged ahead in time. LUCKY LIPSTICK angled in some to be just off the inside on the backstretch, advanced to second along the rail on the second bend, floated out some entering the stretch, battled to keep the place but did not have enough in the waning yards. SONGANDDANCELADY closest to the early speed while in paths two or three, was challenged for second on the second turn, tried hard in the stretch, did not have enough late but was easily best of the rest. STILETTO HEELS hesitated than swiped the gate as she broke in the air, chased just off the inside, angled out some entering the lane, moved out a bit further for a clear path upper stretch but had no late bid. JOYCE G was soon well back, saved ground, floated out some into the lane then had little to offer. AUTUMN GLORY steadily faded from paths three or four.
