WAKI DAME broke alertly, set the pace in hand from well off the rail, was let out on the second turn, drew clear and maintained control under a right whip in the lane. SAVANNAH MIST split rivals two wide on the backstretch to advance, chased WAKI DAME from inside, tried hard in the stretch but was no match for that one late. IRON MAIDEN TOO steadily improved position along the rail to threaten midstretch, began to weaken the final furlong, tried to drift out, was steadied on SAVANNAH MIST'S heels late and allowed to drift out further once clear. CITY PRAYER tried to drift out on the first turn, was checked, angled out some on the backstretch, raced in contention between horses, could not keep up on the second turn and lacked a rally four wide in the drive. SITUATION was steadied when crowded on the first turn, vied for the lead outside WAKI DAME on the backstretch, began to tire on the second turn and lugged in through the stretch. I'M A LIL SALTY was an early factor behind WAKI DAME but also had little left after a half mile. PANDA BEAR raced in contention outside for more than a half mile but also faltered once into the second turn.
