### Footnotes

SCHEFFLERA forwardly placed inside, altered out four wide for a clear path upper stretch, was all out the last eighth and got up in the final strides. PEACH BOTTOM a step slow at the start, was hustled up from outside, three wide taking the bend, gained the lead upper stretch, was under a stern drive the final furlong but did not have enough in the waning yards. MY ITALIAN POSH showed first, was soon chasing GLORY CHASER from just off the inside, took the rail into the bend, had every chance the last through the lane, could not close the gap but caught GLORY CHASER for the show. GLORY CHASER moved clear from outside after travelling the first furlong, stayed just off the inside taking the turn, was challenged from both sides at the top of the stretch and slowly yielded. HERE GUCCI soon trailed just off the rail, angled out on the turn, came into the lane from the middle of the track, gained a little ground upper stretch then leveled off. SOLD FOR GOLD raced in contention between rivals for nearly a half mile then gave way.
