Footnotes

CANYON DE ORO, crowded and bumped at the start, made up ground three and four wide on the backstretch, went for the lead outside leaving the second turn, took the advantage under the whip nearing the sixteenth pole, never moved clear but held on under a left whip. LITTLE JOE TUBB advanced between rivals to take the lead on the second turn, moved clear under the whip through the upper stretch, was all out late but did not have enough left. SPANISH CHARM was settled outside for a half mile, picked up his pace leaving the second turn and passed beaten ones five wide the final furlong. MATCHED was bumped and shuffled back at the start, chased the pace not far off the rail, advanced three wide leaving the second turn but lacked a response between horses in the lane. ADDA DRUMS forced the pace from inside on the first turn, took over on the backstretch but gave way through the drive. DOUBLEDIGITDOMEDOG showed little racing three wide. NICCOLA broke alertly but bolted on the first turn, was taken under control on the backstretch, forced the pace between horses, faltered going into the second turn, was pulled up and walked off. RED'S ROLLIN reared at the start and lost his rider.
