Footnotes

ILLINI DESTINY prominent between horses, was two wide on the bend, floated out some upper stretch, gained the lead nearing the sixteenth marker, was briefly clear, drifted out through the waning yards and just lasted. ROYAL TOUR a bit slow at the break, advanced from outside, lost ground four and five wide taking the bend, closed well, was too late but got second in the final strides. ROBYN THE TILL well placed inside, failed to keep up along the rail on the turn, altered out some upper stretch as he closed the gap, was steadied briefly when his path narrowed just before the sixteenth marker and was also getting to ILLINI DESTINY nearing the wire. SINGALONGWITH BERT whose rider did not carry a whip, broke in stride, was soon chasing others from between horses, three and four wide through the turn, came again upper stretch but could only make up minor ground late. MR AUSTIN in contention between rivals on the backstretch, appeared to steady early in the turn, was just off the inside with a quarter mile left, altered out six wide upper stretch then drifted out as he was making a belated surge inside the last furlong. MONSTER DRIVE soon had the lead, saved ground on the turn then gradually wore down the last furlong. TOAST THE GHOST was an early factor from inside, came off the rail some on the bend, three wide entering the lane then made up some ground deep stretch. SIR MILLER far back early, picked up his pace from inside on the turn, swung out to path four into the stretch, altered in after entering the last furlong and was steadily closing the gap. GOLDFELLOW was also soon well back, saved ground through the turn, lacked a stretch bid and was angled out inside the final eighth. SANDS RED B a factor between horses on the backstretch, faded three wide leaving the turn, fanned out to the middle of the track for the stretch run, was eased and returned bleeding from the nostrils.
