Footnotes

CITY WIFE showed first, shared the lead from outside, drew away and stayed just off the inside through the turn and maintained full control under steady urging in the lane. CAP'N SWIFTER vied for the lead from inside on the backstretch, could not stay close on the bend, was all out through the stretch and proved clearly second best. SANTA TRINITA was an early factor just off the inside, did not keep up through the turn, floated out to path four into the stretch, battled for third and narrowly prevailed. PLEASE BOUNDARY in contention toward the outside on the backstretch, backed up three wide through the turn, fanned widest for the drive, lacked a significant response but was closing in for the show in the waning yards. MISS BOCEPHUS also a factor while between rivals on the backstretch, did not stay close while just off the inside on the turn, fanned out some for the drive, fought for third but did not have enough left late. SARA'S GOLDMINE hustled along early, saved ground taking the bend, came off the rail a bit entering the lane, also battled for the show but yielded deep stretch. OKEFENOKEE trailed from outside, angled in on the turn and had no stretch bid. SUNTAN BABY without speed from between horses, stayed well off the inside through the turn and was empty for the drive.
