RAP ON FELIX settled outside, picked up his pace nearing the second bend, circled rivals, closed the gap on the leader while under drive, took over inside the final sixteenth then began to draw off without urging. BOIS D'ARC FOREST rated just off the early speed, advanced between rivals to gain the advantage with a half mile to go, soon moved clear, saved ground through the second turn, tried hard in the lane, did not have enough left but was easily second best. YIELD progressed to contention while staying off the inside on the backstretch, was two wide on the second bend, fanned out to path four entering the stretch, lugged in under right-handed pressure just inside the last furlong and could only move clear for third in the waning yards. EUROPA'S BEST fractious behind the gate, was bumped and steadied after the break, gradually progressed from inside on the backstretch, two wide on the second turn, altered his path twice upper stretch, was cut off after entering the last eighth, checked, altered out then steadily drifted out in the late going. SOUP MAN settled inside, commenced his bid on the second turn, swung out three wide leaving that bend, altered in for a clear path upper stretch, was caught in tight quarters inside the furlong marker, steadied, forced out then steadily altered out to stay clear of EUROPA'S BEST the final sixteenth. GLASSHOUSE boxed in early, gained a clear path after a half mile, took over second two wide on the second bend but flattened out in the lane. CAN GO CHARLIE displayed early speed from inside but gave way along the rail on the second turn. SKIPPIN DYLAN drifted out some after the break, bumping EUROPA'S BEST, moved up from outside to share the lead on the backstretch, quit three wide on the second turn, distanced himself through the stretch and was walked off. There was a stewards' inquiry into the stretch run. After their review, YIELD was disqualified for coming in without being clear inside the last furlong, causing interference to EUROPA'S BEST and SOUP MAN. YIELD was placed fifth.
