Footnotes

NOW YOU'RE MAD bumped with PROPER ONE at the break, was rated outside the early speed, went for the lead two wide on the turn, was clear leaving the bend, lengthened command upper stretch under urging, began to tire inside the final furlong but held off WALKABOUT MOLLY under left-handed pressure. WALKABOUT MOLLY hustled along to prompt the pace from inside, was outrun into the bend, gradually angled out, came three wide for the drive, moved clear for second, was all out, closed well but came up short. PROPER ONE bumped with NOW YOU'RE MAD at the start, progressed just off the inside on the turn, fanned four wide into the stretch and also found best stride too late. PRISSY RULER unruly in the gate, was taken outside early on once the race began, lost ground widest through the bend then made a good but belated bid the last furlong. COOL KID broke in stride, angled in quickly to show the way just off the inside, took the rail into the turn, could not stay with NOW YOU'RE MAD on the turn, came off the inside some for the stretch run and flattened out. MISCHIEF N MAYHEM steadily faded from inside, floated out into the lane and had little left.
