ANAKA was sent to share the lead from inside, responded when asked leaving the turn, steadily drew away from the rest and was kept to task to the wire. TAP CITY was well placed inside from the early going, battled for second in the lane and got the nod in a tight photo. UMMA UMMA was kept close under an early whip between horses, three wide on the turn, floated out to path five into the lane, was bumped upper stretch and slowly forced in as she fought for the place and just missed in a game effort. STEELA broke inward, bumping LUCKY TIP, was without early foot toward the outside, angled in entering the turn, fanned out to path four into the lane, was blocked with a furlong left, altered outside LUCKY TIP at the sixteenth pole and did not have the needed late surge. HAWKSTER'S ROSE soon trailed well off the inside, was moved to the inside into the bend and checked along the rail behind TAP CITY midstretch. LUCKY TIP was pinched back at the start, hustled up under an early whip, advanced four wide on the turn, lost further ground fanning outside UMMA UMMA into the lane, lugged in and bumped the latter upper stretch and slowly yielded the last eighth. HOLIDAY HUSTLE jostled briefly with LUCKY TIP at the break, raced in contention between horses briefly then faded five wide on the turn. SECA TREACE contested the pace from outside, moved clear early in the turn, was soon overtaken from inside, in path three leaving the bend and gave way between rivals.
