U. S. S. SPENCER was quickly clear, soon had the inside, all out deep stretch and held off WINDS DUE EAST. The latter, in midpack early, commenced her bid along the rail on the turn, floated out to path three for the drive, pulled clear for second, closed well but came up a bit short. MINNIE SUNSHINE was bumped solidly at the start and forced outward, just off the rail through the bend, lugged in some midstretch, made a strong move the last eighth and was clearly best of the rest. COUSIN HALEY an early factor from outside, was just off the rail on the turn, fanned four wide into the lane and ran evenly. SASSY BUCK soon trailed from outside, three to five wide taking the turn then closed the gap some through the stretch without threatening. CARRIE ANN SURECAN broke outward, bumped hard with MINNIE SUNSHINE, tracked COUSIN HALEY'S path through the turn and had no late bid. NO ORDINARY COWGIRL tried to drift out several times on the backstretch, saved ground taking the bend and was empty for the drive. PRETTY PERCEPTIVE forwardly placed outside, drifted out through the turn and into the lane and had little left in the stretch.
