ROYALRAP a step slow at the break, rushed up from outside to share the lead, gradually angled in through the turn, was two wide on the bend, moved clear upper stretch, was under a drive to the final sixteenth then finished in hand. FLY BO FLY chased from inside, angled out taking the bend, came five wide into the stretch, found best stride the last eighth and caught MONARCH THUNDER for second near the wire. MONARCH THUNDER contested the pace just off or along the rail, could not stay with ROYALRAP in the lane, began to weaken inside the final eighth, angled out some with a sixteenth left and was outfinished. HOPPY'S LONG SHOT in contention between horses early, moved to the rail leaving the bend and was gradually making up ground on the second flight through the lane. DAKOTA'S COURT vied for the lead just off the inside, appeared to float out some entering the turn, failed to keep up three wide and slowly yielded in the stretch. MADMADSKILLZ an early factor, faded from inside on the turn. FORECLOSED was bumped and forced in some as he disputed the pace nearing the end of the first furlong, did not keep up entering the turn, followed DAKOTA'S COURT into the bend, fanned out some for the drive and continued to fade. DR. CALAHAN was soon far back, saved ground through the turn and only passed a couple tired ones in the stretch. KAI'S BLESSING void of speed from outside, stayed in path three through the bend and was empty for the drive. JACKIE MC gradually altered in trying to stay clear of ROYALRAP, bumped FORCLOSED near the five-eighths pole, dueled for the lead between horses, was checked when his path narrowed into the bend, swung out and steadily gave way running widest. The rider of JACKIE MC lodged an objection alleging interference from ROYALRAP early in the turn. After their review, the stewards did not uphold that claim.
