Footnotes

HOPEFUL SWEEPER contested the pace from inside, moved clear on the turn, was under a drive in the lane and maintained control. CAUSEGOOD pressed from outside, moved clear for second from path three on the turn, was all out in the stretch but could only maintain her position. SMITTENBUTSPITTIN' checked when her path narrowed shortly after the break, advanced from inside on the turn, angled out some for a clear path upper stretch, angled outside CAUSEGOOD after entering the last furlong and finished evenly. SET FOR SPEED without early speed from outside, lost considerable ground widest through the turn and found best stride too late inside the final eighth. CLEOTA displayed early speed just off the inside, was outrun into the bend, gradually swung out, came five wide into the stretch and had no late bid. ALASKAN HOT ROD soon trailed, was in path three on the turn, angled out some for a clear path near the furlong marker and passed between tired ones. HOT DAME prominent between horses, faded four wide on the bend. HALFDRESSED void of speed, was just off the inside through the turn and empty in the stretch. PLEASANT RYDER saved ground taking the bend and also had little to offer for the drive. BELLA RED MARIE displayed early speed between rivals but gave way just off the inside leaving the turn.
