Footnotes

R RICH E. RICH contested the pace just off the inside from the beginning, took the rail on the turn, was roused into the lane, responded to hand urging and gradually pulled away inside the final furlong. HANGMAN vied for the lead between horses, moved in beside R RICH E. RICH into the bend, was also asked entering the stretch, gave futile chase while all out inside the last eighth but held onto the place. PORTERVILLE dueled for the early lead between rivals, could not keep up nearing the turn, saved ground taking the bend, lacked the needed late kick but caught LOGAN'SSHOREBREEZE for third. LOGAN'SSHOREBREEZE displayed early speed just outside HANGMAN but slowly wore down deep stretch. LEGATANGO showed first but was soon chasing the pacesetters from outside, could not stay close four wide on the turn and ran evenly the last quarter mile. DON TIGER (ARG) void of speed from outside, failed to have a stretch bid. SMOOTH CART was taken inside early on and showed little. LUCKY NATIVE just off or along the rail throughout, was never a factor.
