Footnotes

REVOLUTION ROAD rated from outside, advanced three wide on the bend, was forced to fan eight wide for a clear path into the stretch, lugged in some under a steady right whip but got up in time. ELI'S MAGIC steadily progressed between rivals, was just off the inside entering the turn, waited for room leaving the bend, got through four wide into the lane, gained a slight lead, was all out as he tried to hold on but had to settle for second best. BORN SUPREME in the second flight, came off the rail nearing the half mile marker, was three to five wide taking the turn, vied for the lead upper stretch but did not have enough left inside the last furlong. DEVIL'S BEAU in midpack from outside on the backstretch, was three wide on the turn, lost ground fanning six wide into the lane, jostled with BULL BAYOU through upper stretch, angled outside REVOLUTION ROAD with a sixteenth to go then continued to drift out. ANOTHER TALL TALE without early foot, made up ground along the rail on the bend, came out some for a clear path entering the stretch, gained a striking position soon after but could only pass some tired ones late. BULL BAYOU gradually angled out as he helped prompt the pace on the backstretch, was four wide into the turn, carried out to the middle of the track for the drive, jostled through upper stretch, was steadied inside the furlong marker gradually faded. SAN CART soon faded between horses, two to four wide taking the turn and lacked a significant stretch bid. SUNSET BEACH contested the pace from outside, two wide on the turn, floated out some into the lane and flattened out the last furlong. NORTHERN GUY vied for the lead inside but gave way for the drive. CHEROKEE TALK was checked back from crowding shortly after the start and showed little in a ground-saving trip.
