IMMINENT STORM rated from inside, saved ground taking the turn, was all out in the lane but got up in the waning yards. JACK'S BIG FELLA bumped with LYDDANE BRIDGE RD at the start, was quickly clear and stayed off the inside, was just off the rail when he was roused leaving the bend, under steady urging in the stretch but began to tire and gradually drift out in the late going. GRAND PROCESSION chased the early speed from inside, swung outside the leader on the turn, floated out to path four into the lane, had every chance but finished evenly. THIS HERE GUITAR was away slowly, hustled up between horses, angled in midway on the turn and passed tired ones through the stretch. LYDDANE BRIDGE RD bumped with JACK'S BIG FELLA at the start, was soon chasing from outside, just off the rail taking the bend and ran evenly through the lane. COME ON SLEW chased widest on the backstretch, was three then four wide taking the turn and had no late bid. CEDAR KEY SUNSET was also away slowly then failed to menace in a ground-saving trip. GRACIES BRUDDER boxed in between rivals and looking for room on the backstretch, was just off the rail on the turn, swung out widest for the stretch run and proved empty.
