RUNAWAY DO drifted in to bump WHISPER AND RUN leaving the gate, stayed close outside RUN RAINY RUN, was put to a drive leaving midstretch, took the lead before the sixteenth pole and widened command late under a hand drive. RUN RAINY RUN broke alertly, set the pace two off the rail, drifted out some on the turn, was put to a right whip once straightened for home, lugged in midstretch and was no match for the winner through the late going. WHISPER AND RUN was bumped leaving the gate, hustled up to press the pace inside RUN RAINY RUN, moved off the rail abruptly leaving the eighth pole, drifted out further and did not have a late bid. GOLD DIGGERS DAWN raced evenly four wide. AS ALWAYS was quickly outrun and trailed racing wide.
