Footnotes

WILL'S HONEY contested the pace off the rail but inside his rivals on the backstretch, had the rail on the bend, drifted out to path three entering the stretch, edged ahead as he battled in close quarters just inside GOTCHA CART approaching the sixteenth marker, brushed with that one in the late going but held on. GOTCHA CART broke in the air, moved up between horses to vie for the lead three wide on the turn, fanned out some for the stretch run, fought gamely beside WILL'S HONEY, brushed with that one late, lacked the extra needed but was clearly second best. GOLDFINDER urged along to duel for the early lead between rivals, could not stay with the top pair while two wide leaving the turn, altered outside GOTCHA CART entering the lane, began to drift out with a sixteenth to go and could only hold his position deep stretch. APACHE HONOR prominent from outside on the backstretch, lost ground four to six wide through the bend, drifted out briefly midstretch and finished evenly. STORMING VOW came off the inside midway on the backstretch, began to fade just off the rail on the turn, swung out to path five into the lane and had no late bid. WIRECLOUD without speed from outside, was three wide taking the turn and also lacked a stretch rally. INCLUDE THE BLING void of speed, though urged along, saved ground and failed to menace. SIR MILLER never far off the inside, showed little.
