AWESOME RULES rushed to take the lead entering the first turn, set a pressured pace to the final turn, responded well and drew well clear late. TAXCO stalked the early pace from the three path, was in striking position nearing the furlong marker when headed by PRESENTS FOR BERTI then rallied for a game effort. SUNDAY SAINT was nicely rated in the opening stages, roused nearing the second turn and responded well while racing five wide. OUST raced five wide around the first turn, settled towards the rear when straightening out, sat in a rating position to the final turn and improved his position late. POPLAR HOUSE trailed the field early and passed tiring rivals. PRESENTS FOR BERTI tracked the pace from the rail moved to striking position around the second turn to battle at the eighth pole then retreated. TIO CHENCHO raced six wide nearing the first turn, gained position around the turn to be in good position entering the backstretch, was close to the leaders late but tired. HOT NEEDLE vied for the lead to the half pole, battled to the second turn then tired. SOON raced in company from the three path and faded early. BOOT TAILS was well back along the rail, eased in the late going, pulled up after the wire and was vanned off.
