Footnotes

MAKE HER A STAR broke alertly, showed the way in hand from paths two or three, was let out on the turn, gradually opened up on the rest and was under steady urging as she drifted out deep stretch. GARCON B. SIX without early foot between horses, was just off the inside on the bend, drifted out to the middle of the track for the drive and got up for second in the waning yards. SHINY STAR was prominent from outside, lost ground four and five wide taking the turn and could only catch LITTLE MS. DAISEY for third near the wire. LITTLE MS. DAISEY pressed MAKE HER A STAR from just outside, moved clear for second on the bend, proved no match for the latter when set down for the drive and lugged in deep stretch as she began to wear down. MA CHER AMIO showed no early speed from inside, fanned out to path five entering the lane and altered outside SHINY STAR abruptly inside the final sixteenth. CART'S FAIRYTALE swiped the gate breaking inward, quickly advanced to contention between rivals, gradually moved inside nearing the turn, failed to keep up on the bend, floated to path three for the drive and lacked the needed late bid. FREELY soon trailed, saved ground then altered out for a clear path deep stretch as she began to make up some ground.
