Footnotes

SMOKEY AROMA broke in stride, quickly had a clear lead, showed the way in hand from inside, was roused leaving the quarter pole and was kept to urging until the last seventy yards. OFFICER MCNEAL settled just off the inside, gradually progressed on the backstretch, saved ground taking the second bend, steadily advanced in the lane, pulled clear for second inside the last furlong and angled out some as he closed the gap on the leader in the waning yards. RAGGEDY HOBO steadied back from crowding at the break, altered inside before reaching the first turn, bid along the rail on the second bend, came off the inside some for the drive, battled for second upper stretch but hung in the late going. NO SONG N DANCE rated from outside on the backstretch, commenced his bid four wide on the second turn but ran evenly the last quarter mile. TIO CHENCHO forwardly placed just off the inside, floated out some leaving the second turn and faded between horses. BALTIC VERSE hustled along from the beginning, chased three wide then began to tire between rivals leaving the second bend. MIAMI ICE soon dropped back, moved to the rail on the first turn, began to close the gap just off the rail on the second bend, angled out midstretch but failed to have a significant response.
