MAGGIE'S MONEY stalked from outside, commenced her bid three wide on the turn, gained the lead upper stretch, moved clear inside the last eighth and was kept to task to the wire. NAJCAT steadied behind traffic just after the break, was settled outside, picked up her pace widest through the bend and drew off for second the last seventy yards. J'S APPROVAL forwardly placed just off the inside, took over two wide on the turn, could not stay with MAGGIE'S MONEY inside the last furlong and gradually yielded. ALASKAN PARADOX in contention from inside, came off the rail some for the stretch run, angled out some at the furlong marker and began to tire. TOUGH TALKIN ANNIE a factor between rivals, fanned four wide for the drive and weakened inside the last eighth. LA OUTLAW unruly behind the gate, was void of speed once the race began, saved ground taking the turn, closed the gap some upper stretch, came off the rail inside the last furlong and lacked a significant response. CANNETELLA was soon clear and inside, lost the lead on the bend and continued to fade in the lane. WONDERELLO three to four wide throughout, was empty for the drive.
