**Footnotes**

BOLD STANDARD blocked early, waited for room along the rail on the turn, got through three wide at the head of the lane, vied for the lead on even terms inside MR. CANYON RUN and got the nod at the wire. MR. CANYON RUN jostled briefly with SANDS RED B when caught in tight quarters nearing the end of the first furlong, altered out some, moved to the outside on the turn, lost considerable ground fanning to the middle of the track for the stretch run, rallied to had a narrow advantage with furlong left, fought gamely but had to settle for second best. STRATEMATIC was slowest from the gate, advanced along the rail on the turn, swung out four wide for the stretch run, had an easy striking position at the eighth pole but could only take over third late. ONE HAPPY CAT bumped at the start, disputed the pace outside HARKEY MALARKY, had the lead just off the inside entering the lane, was no match for the top pair the final furlong and gradually wore down through the waning yards. JUST VIAREGGIO prominent between horses early, bid three wide on the bend, floated out further into the stretch and did not have enough left. MUSICAL TYPE forwardly placed outside, came six wide into the stretch and lacked the needed bid. HARKEY MALARKY showed first and dueled for the lead between horses, gained the rail on the turn and flattened out for the drive. SANDS RED B jostled briefly with MR. CANYON RUN near the five-furlong marker, was well placed inside, blocked going to the bend, came off the rail some at that point, faltered between horses on the turn, drifted out entering the stretch and had little left. HALLELUJAH SQUARE broke awkwardly, showed no speed from outside, stayed wide through the bend, altered in at head of the lane and had no response.
