**Footnotes**

PERFECT CUP OF TEA shared the lead from between horses, moved clear into the second turn, stayed just off the inside, floated out to path four into the lane, was under steady urging and held off Z Z POP. The latter, fractious behind the gate, was prominent just off the inside once the race began, lost ground fanning outside PERFECT CUP OF TEA entering the stretch, took over second with a sixteenth to go and was closing in on the leader in the waning yards. PRINCESS BUFFY whose rider did not carry a whip, was urged along at the start to be well placed inside, moved clear for second on the second bend, did not have enough left in the lane but was clearly best of the rest. SASSY BUCK without early foot from inside, made her move along the rail on the second turn, lost ground when she was swung outside Z Z POP for the stretch run then could only hold her position in the late going. SONGANDDANCELADY jostled with WINDS DUE EAST at the start and was shuffled back, advanced from outside on the backstretch, was four wide on the second turn, altered out to path eight upper stretch and progressed without threatening. OLE GRAY also bumped with WINDS DUE EAST at the break, was soon well back just outside SASSY BUCK, moved with that one on the second turn, was carried out seven wide into the lane and flattened. CARRIE ANN SURECAN a contender between horses on the backstretch, failed to keep up five wide on the second bend, swung out eight wide for a clear path into the lane, altered out some when SONGANDDANCELADY came close upper stretch and continued to fade. CROSSWISE contested the pace between foes to the second turn then gave way. WINDS DUE EAST squeezed and jostled between rivals at the start, moved up to contention from outside on the backstretch but faded six wide on the second turn. CONSIDER THEMEX displayed early speed from outside, quit four wide on the second bend, drifted out into the lane, was eased through the stretch and walked off.
