Footnotes

DAZZLIN DAY broke alertly, set a pressured pace, stayed just off the inside taking the bend, moved clear when allowed leaving the turn, was put to a drive the last eighth and gradually opened up. PRECIOUS RAJA prominent between horses from the beginning, advanced along the rail on the turn and fought for second through the lane. APT TO DANCE pressed DAZZLIN DAY from outside, was three wide through the turn, fought to hold onto second in the stretch, was narrowly outfinished but proved easily best of the rest. FAT'S GRAY GIRL raced in the second flight between foes, backed up some just off the rail on the turn, swung four wide into the lane and leveled off. DONTFLATERYOURSELF was an early contender from inside, failed to stay close along the rail on the turn, floated out some for the stretch run and continued to yield. ANGELORE was taken inside early on and failed to menace. GREAT MILLENNIUM spotted the field a couple lengths at the break, had no early speed, stayed well off the inside taking the turn and was empty for the drive.
