**Footnotes**

TYKER broke inward, moved up quickly from inside to gain the lead before finishing the first quarter mile, soon moved clear, was roused in the lane and continued to lengthen command under a steady drive. COURT COMPOSER taken inside midway on the backstretch, advanced along the rail through the bend, came off the inside a bit for a clear path upper stretch and gradually pulled away for the place. KAI'S BLESSING prominent from outside, moved clear for second four wide on the turn, lacked the extra in the lane, was forced in and steadied briefly with a sixteenth left but finished on even terms with PRAIRIE PRINCE. The latter chased from outside, bid five wide on the bend, could not stay with the top pair in the lane but battled to keep third, lugged in with a sixteenth left and finished evenly. SOUTHERN DREAMER an early factor between rivals, faded four wide on the turn, angled out some for the drive and passed a few rivals without threatening. FANTINI (MEX) away slowly, stayed well off the inside taking the turn and passed some tired ones from outside in the stretch. GLORY B N GREY in contention between rivals, began to tire two wide on the bend. ALFIE WIGLETT also prominent between horses on the backstretch, gave way three wide on the turn, moved to the rail at the head of the lane and was solidly held in check as his path narrowed after entering the last eighth. CATCH THE OUTLAW displayed early speed between horses but began to tire two wide on the bend and steadily faded.
