Footnotes

ZANY LADY was urged to share the lead inside, moved clear of OURSECONDBUCK when put to a drive in the upper stretch, gradually drifted out through the lane and received a corrective right whip late. OURSECONDBUCK shared the lead outside ZANY LADY through the turn, gave futile chase three wide in the lane and held onto the place. MARYETT was settled outside, crowded and brushed early on the turn, reached an easy striking position three wide at the quarter pole but raced evenly between rivals in the lane. PEPPER KEY was bumped leaving the gate, settled off the rail, made a mild bid four wide going to the eighth pole and lugged in through the deep stretch. BALBOAS OUTSTANDIN drifted in to bump PEPPER KEY leaving the gate, was steadied back, taken inside, angled out on the turn and advanced late five wide. SISTER SISTER raced close up inside on the backstretch, moved off the rail into the turn, brushed with MARYETT, was blocked through the turn, angled out leaving the quarter mile marker, drifted out further entering the stretch and lacked a rally six wide. QUINTINA was an early factor between rivals, dropped back from shrinking space into the turn, moved to the rail, failed to have a stretch bid and lost her path to PEPPER KEY late. REVERSE CODE repeatedly checked behind SISTER SISTER from the five furlong marker to the four furlong pole, moved to the outside after that, was sternly urged to pick up her pace outside on the turn, carried out by SISTER SISTER into the stretch and failed to respond seven wide in the lane.
