Footnotes

AIDAN'S SLEW moved outside after three furlongs, took the lead three wide on the second turn, angled in some leaving that bend, floated out upper stretch, was corrected, under a drive in the late going and held sway. COURT COMPOSER hustled up along the rail under the whip, contested the pace to the second bend, was overtaken, floated out some into the lane, gave futile chase while all out but proved clearly second best. DISTANT MAGIC settled between horses, gradually progressed on the backstretch, took the rail into the second turn, gained third and a striking position upper stretch, moved outside COURT COMPOSER nearing the sixteenth marker and finished evenly. RIVER CLIFF steadily advanced from inside, swung out widest on the second bend and came into contention, was four wide entering the stretch and hung for the drive. PROPANE broke alertly, shared the lead three wide, angled in beside COURT COMPOSER nearing the second turn, could not keep up just off the inside leaving that bend, fanned outside COURT COMPOSER for the drive and continued to wear down. KING OF THE DESERT void of speed from outside, moved to the rail into the second turn and had little left. GOTTADOIT displayed early speed two wide but tired approaching the second turn and steadily gave way.
