**Footnotes**

ANAKA gradually angled in as she contested the pace from outside, was just off the rail on the turn, moved clear when asked leaving the bend and held off OFFICER PHILLY under steady urging. OFFICER PHILLY was slowly forced in the first furlong as she vied for the lead, backed up some along the rail midway with nine-sixteenths left, angled outside on the turn, floated out to path five for the stretch run, took over second nearing the final sixteenth and was closing the gap late. LUCKY TIP advanced from outside to threaten three wide on the bend, proved no match for ANAKA when set down for the drive and gradually wore down the last eighth. UMMA UMMA altered her path repeatedly trying to stay clear the first half mile, swung out six wide upper stretch and failed to have a late bid. TAP CITY also gradually forced in after entering the main track, dueled for the lead inside ANAKA, had the rail on the turn, could not keep up leaving the bend, altered out four wide upper stretch for a clear path but did not have enough left. LAST CORONA displayed brief speed inside, was checked when her path was taken after travelling a furlong, taken to the outside, stayed wide through the bend and was empty for the drive.
