**Footnotes**

DOUBLE LUCKY well placed inside, waited for room through the turn, got through two wide at the head of the lane and drew off under a drive inside the final furlong. UNO BLISS rated from inside, saved ground through the bend, threatened along the rail midstretch but could only pull clear for second the last sixteenth. HOT DAME disputed the pace from inside, floated out some nearing the eighth pole and began to yield shortly after that. CHICAGO CALI chased from outside, was just off the rail taking the bend, gained a striking position upper stretch, altered out some for a clear path inside the last furlong but hung in the waning yards. CLARA'S GROVE moved out between rivals after the first furlong, was blocked while two and three wide through the turn, gained a clear path midstretch, altered out some to stay clear of CHICAGO CALI nearing the sixteenth marker and finished evenly. HALFDRESSED hit the side of the gate as she left it, contested the pace between rivals, was two wide leaving the bend, floated out some entering the lane and flattened out. FEISTY FOLEY was hustled along to duel for the lead toward the outside, came four wide into the stretch and also tired. CONTEZZA void of speed, was just off the inside on the turn, swung widest for the drive but had no late bid. BELLERIVE inattentive at the break, broke inward, was soon far back, had the rail on the turn, floated out entering the stretch and had little to offer. SET FOR SPEED displayed early speed from outside, came five wide into the lane and gave way.
