Footnotes

UNBRIDLED FABULO showed first, set the pace inside, drew clear on the bend, drifted out leaving the turn, was all out in the lane, lugged in some nearing the sixteenth marker but held on. A. P. PRIME pressed UNBRIDLED FABULO from just outside, took the rail leaving the bend, steadily closed the gap through the stretch and narrowly missed the win. MOST FANTASTIC raced in contention from outside, angled in between horses entering the turn, was just off the inside into the lane, rallied, was blocked behind UNBRIDLED FABULO deep stretch, got through outside the latter nearing the wire and kept third. PHIL N MARTY jostled between rivals at the start, was settled inside, picked up his pace on the turn, fanned out to path four for the drive, rallied belatedly but was easily best of the rest. LOGAN N MITCH jostled with PHIL N MARTY at the break, was prominent from inside on the backstretch but faded along the rail on the turn. NO LIMIT GAME bumped at the start, was without speed though hustled along from outside, just off the rail on the turn, drifted out to path six entering the lane and had no late bid. DOC WEBSTER tried to flip in the gate, was taken out of his stall, found okay to race by the veterinarian, was reloaded, also jostled with PHIL N MARTY at the start, displayed brief speed between rivals but gave way three wide leaving the bend.
