BOSTON OUTLAW stalked the early speed from outside, made his bid on the turn, came into the lane three wide, moved ahead upper stretch and gradually moved clear under a drive inside the last eighth. NICKY'S DELIGHT was soon well back, picked up his pace into the bend, swung outside on the turn, drifted out to path six entering the stretch, made a strong move under steady urging, took over second with seventy yards left and was closing on the leader late. RAY JAY hustled clear shortly after the break, showed the way just off the inside, was challenged on the turn, could not hold back BOSTON OUTLAW upper stretch and gradually wore down the final furlong. GREATTOBEABEAVAR was a contender from outside on the backstretch, failed to keep up into the bend, angled in some, was three wide entering the lane and passed tired ones without threatening. EXECUTIVE COACH forwardly placed inside, came off the rail some entering the stretch and flattened out. HOTROD STICK was steadied several times while boxed in between horses on the backstretch, just off the rail on the turn, began to fade leaving the bend, fanned four wide into the lane and continued to give way. R RICH E. RICH left the gate throwing his head, advanced between horses, was blocked nearing the turn, three wide into the bend, could not stay close, moved to the rail leaving the turn and steadily faded.
