Footnotes

PORTERVILLE rated off the early speed, progressed three wide on the turn, fanned out further for the stretch run, was all out and edged ahead of HANGMAN nearing the wire. HANGMAN away slowly, moved up quickly from outside to gain the advantage three wide leaving the bend, moved ahead upper stretch, fought gamely in the late going but did not have enough left. ILIKEWHATIAMDOING showed first, contested the pace between rivals, two wide through the turn, retreated some upper stretch, did not relent but lacked the extra needed in the late going. GOLDFINDER unruly in the gate, raced in contention just off the inside, swung out widest leaving the turn and could only make up minor ground deep stretch. LOGAN'SSHOREBREEZE chased from inside, closed the gap along the rail on the bend, altered out four wide for a clear path upper stretch and also lacked a significant bid. LEGATANGO soon trailed from outside, was just off the inside on the turn, floated out entering the lane and lacked a rally. PRINCIPAL BALANCE disputed the pace just off the inside, gained the rail into the turn and gave way in the stretch.
