### Footnotes

TRS CHASIN THE SKIRT broke outward, bumped with BOLDSSMASHANDDASH, was corrected, all out, got the lead nearing the sixteenth marker, gradually lugged in late but held sway. DADDY DIAMOND stumbled inward at the break, bumping BOLDSSMASHANDDASH as well, closed well but too late. JJ STONEWALL JAXSON contested the pace, gradually lugged in after entering the final furlong and did not have enough left. EL GRAN DEER DASH broke alertly, dueled for the lead, drifted out some approaching the sixteenth marker and yielded. DASHING STRADER chased and was checked briefly when EL GRAN DEER DASH crossed his path nearing the sixteenth marker. WN LUTHER had no mishap and lacked a late bid. AC MIRACLE BUCKS shied outward as DADDY DIAMOND came close shortly after the break, closed the gap inside the final eighth but leveled off in the waning yards. BOLDSSMASHANDDASH fractious in the gate, was bumped solidly from both sides at the start, checked and lugged in inside the last furlong. ACES DISCO DIAMOND hesitated at the break and showed little. Due to a timer malfunction, the race was hand timed.
