MAXWELL COAST encouraged from between horses, was three then four wide taking the turn, rallied under hand urging in the lane, split rivals four wide shortly after entering the final furlong and moved clear the final sixteenth under a hand ride. SMITTY prominent from outside, backed up some while losing ground five wide on the turn, fanned out further for the stretch run, threatened with a furlong to to but could only catch RAY JAY for the place. RAY JAY bumped at the start, pressed the early speed from between rivals, was four then five wide through the bend, gained a slight advantage nearing the eighth pole but did not have enough left the last sixteenth. HAMMON WARRIOR unruly behind the gate, was loose briefly, caught and loaded into the gate, broke inward, bumping RAY JAY then was bumped by SLICK MICK, chased from outside, lost considerable ground widest through the bend, closed the gap some upper stretch then only improved position late. SPURTABILITY was taken inside early on, gradually angled out through the lane and passed tired ones. SLICK MICK bumped with HAMMON WARRIOR just after the break, raced in contention between horses, angled in some to be just off the rail leaving the turn and began to tire as he altered in trying to stay clear of STUDLEY DORIGHT inside the last furlong. STUDLEY DORIGHT a bit slow and awkward at the break, rushed up from inside to gain the lead, moved clear on the turn, floated out to path three entering the stretch, tired and faded between horses. ALABAMA CLAY an early factor inside, gave way the last furlong.
