Footnotes

WIN TUCKER kept close on the backstretch, commenced his bid three wide on the turn, dueled for the lead under a hand ride in the lane and shook off CAJUN DIABLO in the waning yards. CAJUN DIABLO broke inward, was sent to vie for the lead from inside, moved clear on the turn, floated out a bit at the head of the lane, battled just inside WIN TUCKER, was all out, did not have enough left the last sixty yards but was easily best of the others. MIDNITE KID hustled along from outside, improved position four wide on the turn, fanned out further into the lane, moved clear for third upper stretch then could pull away for that position. BLACKHAWK RED failed to menace in a ground-saving trip. KODA showed first, was urged along to contest the pace from outside, began to tire two wide on the turn, swung out to path four entering the stretch and continued to give way. BARRY K bumped several times with HE'S HOT SAUCE at the start, soon trailed, was just off the inside on the turn, floated out to path four entering the lane, began to angle outside HE'S HOT SAUCE midstretch then steadily altered out as the latter came out the last sixteenth. HE'S HOT SAUCE jostled lightly with BARRY K at the start then was checked behind traffic, chased from outside, moved in to be just off the inside on the bend, gradually moved to the outside upper stretch then drifted out the final sixteenth. LUCKY ALEC chased from between rivals, began to gradually drift out through the bend, came five wide into the stretch, held a straight path but steadily gave way.
