Footnotes

FUTURISTIC progressed just off the inside on the backstretch, waited for room along the rail on the second turn, got through from inside entering the stretch, battled on even terms and slowly edged ahead in the waning yards. PALACE TENOR moved clear from inside on the backstretch, floated out some leaving the second bend, was challenged from both sides, fought gamely but had to settle for second best. DANCIN PEAK advanced between horses on the backstretch, altered out for a clear path at the half mile marker, was just off the rail on the second turn, drifted out to path four entering the lane, gained a slight advantage upper stretch but wore down inside the last eighth. UNDER LIKE THUNDER in contention between rivals, angled in on the second turn, swung out five wide at the head of the lane, threatened with a furlong to go, angled in some after entering the last eighth and tired. GROOVY ANNIE saved ground and failed to menace. SUNDAY SAINT chased from outside, was four to six wide taking the second turn and empty for the drive. SEYRULE vied for the lead briefly just outside PALACE TENOR, did not stay with that one on the backstretch and faded just off the rail leaving the second bend. HOTSHOT VALOR was well placed three wide for more than five furlong, gave way approaching the quarter pole, floated out widest into the lane and continued to fade.
