Footnotes

PALACE TENOR kept close just off the inside, had the rail into the bend, moved outside LUCKY ALEC nearing the quarter pole as he took over second, drifted out upper stretch as he made his bid, held a straight path inside the final furlong and moved ahead if his stablemate the last seventy yards. LUCKY ALEC moved up quickly from outside to gain the lead after travelling the first sixteenth, was soon clear, saved ground through the bend, fought gamely in the lane but did not have enough left. SABAGO prominent between horses, was two then three wide taking the bend, forced out as PALACE TENOR came out upper stretch and failed to have the extra needed the final furlong. WILL'S HONEY in contention from outside, took the turn three, floated out some into the stretch and found best stride too late. COOL EXTERIOR ran evenly in a ground-saving trip. APACHE HONOR without speed from between rivals, was just off the inside entering the turn, swung out on the bend, came five wide into the lane, drifted out midstretch, was corrected but failed to have a significant response. JUST LUKE soon trailed just outside APACHE HONOR, angled out with that one on the turn and entering the stretch and had no late bid.
