Footnotes

SEASCAPE broke outward, bumping POLAR EXPEDITION, moved up between horses to share the lead on the backstretch, drew clear and stayed just off the rail through the second bend, was challenged from outside in the lane, dug in deep stretch and edged ahead the last sixteenth. NAFIR'S BEST broke slowly and bumped solidly with SUNDAY SAINT, advanced from outside, was three wide through the second turn, gained a narrow advantage outside SEASCAPE midstretch, battled to the wire but did not have enough left in the waning yards. CHURUBUSCO forwardly placed between horses, did not stay close three wide on the second bend, fanned out further entering the stretch, made up minor ground and caught NORTHERN REVEAL for third late. NORTHERN REVEAL contested the pace from inside on the backstretch, did not keep up on the second turn, closed the gap some upper stretch then leveled off. OUST chased from between rivals, was three to five wide taking the second turn and gradually made up ground through the stretch without threatening. POPLAR HOUSE soon had the inside, progressed through the second turn, fanned out three wide into the lane and showed a willingness to run late. SUNDAY SAINT also away slowly, was bumped solidly a few strides from the gate, soon far back, gradually picked up his pace on the backstretch, stayed well off the inside taking the second turn, swung out widest for the drive and passed a couple tired rivals. POLAR EXPEDITION bumped at the start, gradually faded from between horses once on the backstretch. KITTEN'S RULE set a pressured pace between horses but gave way after a half mile.
