Footnotes

CHEROKEE BLUE shared the lead between horses, was roused leaving the turn, moved clear from path three inside the final furlong, was all out and held off MISS BOCEPHUS. The latter, in the second flight between rivals, was just off the rail on the bend, fanned four wide for room leaving the turn, steadily make up ground through the lane, was too late but clearly second best. AWESOME ALLEY away slowly, was well back just off the inside, had the rail on the turn, swung out four wide entering the lane, altered out to path six for room nearing the furlong marker and caught LA MILAGRA for third in the waning yards. LA MILAGRA contested the pace from inside, moved ahead on the turn, floated out a bit into the stretch and gradually wore down. MINUS FOURTY FIVE a step slow at the break, soon trailed from inside, floated out some on the turn, came into the lane from path three, angled inside for room upper stretch and passed tired ones. CART LITE also a step slow at the start, was hustled along from outside, three wide on the bend, lost considerable ground fanning to the middle of the track for the drive and lacked a significant response. MINE ATLAST chased the pacesetters from inside, came off the rail some for the drive, flattened and was drifting out late. KEEP ON SIZZLIN displayed early speed from outside, came four wide into the stretch and gave way from between horses.
