FIERY CHICK steadied in tight quarters nearing the first turn, was settled just off the inside, commenced her bid from outside on the second turn, floated out to path five for the stretch run, took over inside the furlong marker, steadily opened up and was under urging until the waning yards. HOLY ALLIANCE was sent to the lead, moved clear on the backstretch, was challenged while along the rail leaving the second bend, was no match for FIERY CHICK the last furlong but drew away for the place. BRUISERS BLACKGOLD broke alertly, was soon chasing HOLY ALLIANCE from outside, made her move at the latter on the second turn, floated out some for the stretch run and gradually wore down. SIX SIXTY also steadied in close quarters nearing the first bend, was settled between horses on the backstretch, picked up her pace from inside on the second turn, closed the gap upper stretch then leveled off inside the final furlong as she was getting to BRUISERS BLACKGOLD. CHICAGO CALI washy in the post parade, advanced from outside on the backstretch, lost position two wide between horses on the second turn, swung out widest for the stretch run and flattened. EASTERS DERBY GIRL forced out some at the break, trailed from outside, was just off the rail taking the second turn and lacked a significant stretch response. LA PAYASA broke outward, was a brief contender but steadily faded from inside once on the backstretch.
