Footnotes

OUTLAW ZEN bumped just after the break, recovered quickly, moved clear after the first sixteenth, saved ground in hand, was roused upper stretch and under a drive until the last sixteenth. RUN WITH EAGLES raced in the second flight from outside, was three wide on the turn, slowly drifted out under left-handed pressure in the stretch, was no match for the winner the last eighth but pulled away for second. DOLLAR FACTOR in contention just off the inside on the backstretch, lost position along the rail on the turn, lacked a significant stretch bid but caught PASS THE PIPE for third late. PASS THE PIPE also chased OUTLAW ZEN from between horses early, was two wide taking the bend and slowly yielded the last eighth. REVOLUTION ROAD drifted out at the start to bump solidly with OUTLAW ZEN, was a factor along the rail on the backstretch but faded three wide on the turn. MIDNITE KID gradually retreated from between foes on the backstretch, was forced out four wide on the turn, floated out some for the drive and had no late bid. LATIN NOTE was soon well back, saved ground taking the turn and empty through the lane. RICK'S TAVERN was forwardly placed outside for a quarter mile, began to pull up in distress nearing the bend and was vanned off.
