MAKIN SOME BUCKS was sent to the lead from inside, moved clear leaving the second turn, was roused upper stretch, all out in the late going and held on. SOCIALLY JADED prominent just off the inside from the early going, was boxed in on the second bend, got through two wide at the head of the lane, slowly closed the gap under a steady drive but came up short. SHAKEEL'S BEST progressed from outside on the backstretch, was two wide into the second turn, floated out some into the stretch, was also all out under continuous urging, did not have enough in the waning yards but was easily best of the rest. FAJITA RITA never far back while saving ground from the early going, had a striking position with a furlong to go but leveled off instead. APT TO BE A STAR four or five wide throughout, failed to menace. MY SILVERDIVA pressed MAKIN SOME BUCKS from outside, failed to keep up two wide leaving the second turn, fanned out behind SHAKEEL'S BEST entering the lane, moved outside that one upper stretch and continued to give way. AUBURN ANNIE along or just off the rail from the first turn, was hustled along but showed little.
