Footnotes

FLY BO FLY rated off the early speed, advanced widest on the backstretch, swiftly took a clear lead three wide on the second turn, was under steady urging in the lane and maintained full control. IZA OF ONYX progressed between rivals to threaten three wide on the second turn, fanned out further into the lane, moved clear for second but was no match for the leader. BOIS D'ARC FOREST forwardly placed three wide, progressed between horses on the second turn, swung out five wide for the stretch run, took over third inside the final furlong and could only make up minor ground on the top pair late. TOCCET ROCKET a step slow at the break, was soon far back, gradually made up ground just off the inside, swung out widest for the stretch run and passed tired ones. AIKMAN pressed from outside, was just off the rail taking the second turn and weakened for the drive. GUILTYGUILTYGUILTY advanced to contention just off the inside on the backstretch but gave way on the second turn. NAPI broke inward, displayed early speed along the rail but began to tire after a half mile. RAGING WATER contested the pace between rivals, took the rail into the second bend and began to tire.
