Footnotes

DANCIN PEAK moved outside the leader leaving the first turn, prompted the pace in close quarters, took the rail on the second bend, rallied to gain a clear lead upper stretch then lengthened command under steady handling. PASS THE MONEY was hustled to a clear lead, showed the way just off the rail, was challenged from inside entering the lane, could not stay with DANCIN PEAK in the stretch but lasted for the place under a drive. JOHNNY CADILLAC was caught in tight quarters between rivals in the second flight shortly after entering the backstretch, gained more room nearing the halfway point, made his move three wide on the second turn, was brushed upper stretch and finished evenly the last furlong. TAXCO advanced outside on the first turn to race in the second flight on the backstretch, was four wide taking the second bend, brushed with JOHNNY CADILLAC nearing the eighth pole and could only make up minor ground in the waning yards. TSUNAMI KING settled inside, came off the rail some on the second turn, was three wide into the lane, angled out five wide for a clear path midstretch, closed well but too late. LEMON CUSTARD soon trailed from outside, moved in beside TSUNAMI KING on the backstretch, angled out some, as that one did, on the second turn, altered out a bit to stay clear of TSUNAMI KING midstretch, moved in some for a better path after entering the last furlong and lacked a significant response. TWYLAS RED CAT also in tight between horses while helping to prompt the pace early on the backstretch, could not keep up approaching a half mile, moved to the rail on the second turn and continued to give way.
