Footnotes

COMMUNION advanced from inside, waited for room on the bend, got through two wide at the top of the stretch, gained the advantage just inside the sixteenth marker and was driven clear. MYGRANDPAISADEACON shared the early lead from outside, moved ahead two wide on the turn, was clear as he floated out further into the lane, was challenged from inside the last eighth and slowly wore down. STORMY JIM settled off the inside, picked up his pace just off the rail on the turn, rallied in the lane, altered outside MYGRANDPAISADEACON inside the final furlong and continued to close the gap. ICANDAZZLE was prominent just off the rail on the backstretch, three to four wide taking the bend then gradually weakened for the drive. KID RIGO contested of the pace between horses, took the rail on the turn, could not keep up leaving the bend and flattened in the stretch. BOLD STANDARD forced out midway on the backstretch, was also three and four wide through the turn, altered outside ICANDAZZLE midstretch and finished evenly. HURRICANE VAMP was altered out some when BOLD STANDARD came out midway on the backstretch, four and five wide on the bend then gradually lugged in through the stretch. RAVING ROCKET was blocked behind the early speed, altered out after travelling a furlong and a half, four wide on the turn, drifted out to the middle of the track into the stretch and drifted out through the waning yards. CALVARY soon trailed from outside, stayed well off the inside taking the turn and was empty for the drive.
