GO GERT GO rated on the front end from inside, drew off from the rest on the backstretch, widened command through the second turn and maintained full control under mild hand urging deep stretch. MINNIE SUNSHINE chased from off the rail, moved to the inside at the halfway point, took over second on the second bend, was all out in the stretch and easily best of the rest. ZONETTA settled outside, moved to the rail nearing the quarter pole, drew clear for third upper stretch then could only just hold her position late. LIL DYNA without speed from inside, swung widest for the drive and lacked a significant response. SHAKEEL'S BEST vied for the lead briefly just outside GO GERT GO, did not stay with that one on the backstretch and began to tire just off the rail on the second turn.
