Footnotes

ROYAL OUTLAW a bit slow at the start, was hustled up from inside to share the lead, battled in the lane, edged ahead inside the last eighth and gradually lengthened his advantage the final sixteenth. CIRCLETHERUNWAY disputed the pace between horses, angled in beside ROYAL OUTLAW on the turn, fought gamely in the stretch, did not have enough left in the late going but was easily best of the rest. LOGOLD'S LUCK soon trailed, commenced his bid along the rail on the turn, moved clear for third upper stretch then had to battle the last eighth to hold his position. LIONELONTHETRACKS void of speed, followed ALTRISTA into the bend, swung out widest leaving the turn, fought for third deep stretch but did not have enough in the waning yards. JACKIE MC vied for the lead between rivals but began to tire three wide leaving the bend. ALTRISTA displayed early speed from outside but faded four wide on the turn. ICONOCLAST also somewhat slow at the break, moved up between rivals to race in contention behind the leaders but faded just off the inside leaving the turn.
