JUDY'S QUEST altered out trying to stay clear of U. S. S. SPENCER after entering the main track, bumped MAKE HER A STAR, was altered in abruptly, progressed along the rail, was roused on the turn, rallied to gain the advantage inside the sixteenth marker then began to draw clear under steady urging. MAG'S POSH was prominent from outside, backed up some three wide on the bend, fanned outside U. S. S. SPENCER for the drive, lugged in midstretch, was corrected and had a brief lead but proved no match for JUDY'S QUEST in the waning yards. U. S. S. SPENCER began to drift out upon entering the main track, was soon straightened, lengthened her lead just off the rail on the bend, floated out to path four into the lane and gradually wore down. MAKE HER A STAR bumped and forced out after entering the main track, was steadied, advanced three wide on the turn, fanned out behind MAG'S POSH into the stretch, gained a striking position, altered outside that one with a furlong left and hung in the late going. MISS BOCEPHUS raced in contention between horses on the backstretch but faded just off the rail on the bend. Z Z POP broke outward, was steadied, taken outside, in path four through the turn, angled in some upper stretch and failed to have a late bid. JUST LIKE JANIE was void of speed from outside, four and five wide taking the turn and was empty for the drive.
