Footnotes

CIN IN CHICAGO chased the early speed from between rivals, two wide through the bend, blocked and steadied at the head of the lane, squeezed through three wide nearing the eighth pole and got the advantage under a drive in the waning yards. HUG THE POSH broke in stride, quickly drew away, in path two entering the stretch, challenged from both sides, fought gamely but had to settle for second best. JUST LUKE was angled in early on, bid along the rail into the stretch, tried to get out with a furlong to go, was quickly corrected, tried hard but did not have enough left. ILLINI DESTINY in the second flight between foes, was three wide through the bend, crowded and forced out some upper stretch and could not keep up late. POWERFUL DOSE in midpack from outside, lost ground four then five wide through the turn and found best stride too late the last eighth. CHRIS AND JADE, outrun to the turn, was just off the rail through the bend, lodged a mild bid into the stretch but could only make up minor ground along the rail the final furlong. SLEW GAMBLER, very wide through the turn, had little to offer under a hand ride in the lane. CATGOTYIRGUN, hustled along early, was checked briefly when her path was taken into the turn, stayed wide on the turn then gradually lugged in under mostly hand urging through the stretch.
