Footnotes

YAZOO MISS boxed in from the early going, got through three wide after passing the quarter pole, floated out to path four into the stretch, was all out, slowly drifted out in the late going but got up at the wire. SECA TREACE broke alertly, soon had the inside as she contested the pace, moved clear leaving the turn but did not have enough left deep stretch and was nabbed at the wire. JULIA'S SONG disputed the pace just outside SECA TREACE, backed up two wide leaving the bend, did not relent, came back under a drive the last furlong but was a bit too late. JOYCE G soon trailed from outside, lost ground as she commenced her bid four wide on the turn, fanned out further for the stretch run, was slowly angled out to stay clear of YAZOO MISS as she made a strong move the last eighth, was also too late but easily best of the rest. PEORIA STAR void of speed though hustled along, was kept close to the inside and failed to menace. WINDS DUE EAST bumped with RACHEL'S STORM at the break, stayed in paths three to five throughout and was not a factor. RACHEL'S STORM bumped with WINDS DUE EAST at the start, was prominent three wide for a half mile then gave way.
